ASRUS is a friendly environment where children and young people with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) are able to socialise with their peers and siblings.

There are lots of different activities available, arts, crafts, cooking, snooker, football and outdoor activities like bushcraft skills.

There are opportunities to find out where to get help to resources needed such as group support, medical and educational information and advice.

Peer support for all families or carers affected by ASD, even if a diagnosis has not been confirmed.
